American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations Govern this Specialty Show

PARKING NOTICE - ALL EXHIBITORS

General parking regulations applies to all.

Day of show parking is free. No space for setups is allowed. Day of show parking is available on Saturday & Sunday and will be open at 6:00 AM. No vehicles allowed in before 6:00AM.

An unloading zone will be provided. Vehicles may not be left unattended and may remain no more than 15 minutes. No unloading in unauthorized areas. Vehicles in violation of parking rules will be towed at owner's expense. All vehicles must be removed from the park by 7:00 PM Sunday.

- **VIP Box Van/Van parking lot - advance reservations only.** No availability at the gate. Box Vans/Vans must leave the grounds by 10:00PM each night. \$100.00 for Saturday & Sunday-No reduction for single day parking.

OVERNIGHT PARKING

- Gates open Thursday, September 1, 2010 at 2:00PM and close at 11:00 PM Thursday, Friday & Saturday. On Saturday & Sunday gates will open at 6:00AM.
- Parking reservations will be assigned in the order reached. Exhibitors wishing to park together must send reservations together.
- Motorhome/Trailer and towed vehicles over 40 feet must unhook and park in general. If you require constant access to and use of towed vehicle it is STRONGLY RECOMMENDED that you reserve two parking spaces.
- **Overnight parking is on gravel. Groundcover is recommended. Fee \$30.00 per night per space. Minimum two nights.**
- **All spaces reserved.** Non-reserved overnight parking available for \$105.00 for three nights or \$75.00 for two nights at the gate.
- Spaces are approximately 25 x 40 feet. No accommodations for slide outs. Must fit in 25 feet or reserve two spaces.
- No dogs may be left out overnight.
- All vehicles must be self-contained. NO discharge of gray water on premises. NO water or electricity available.
- **ALL GENERATOR EXHAUST MUST BE VERTICALLY EXTENDED.** Generators must be off between 11:00PM to 6:00AM.
- All reserve overnight parking must be paid in advance
- Requests for overnight handicapped space must be marked on reservation but is not a guarantee that a space will be available. MUST SEND COPY OF DMV PERMIT.
- Space not claimed by 8:00AM Saturday will not be held and all fees will be forfeited.
- No cancellations, refunds, charges or transfers will be permitted after closing date of September 1, 2010.
- Exhibitors will be responsible for cleanup of their parking spaces.
- The parking privilege is extended by the club and privilege can and will be withdrawn for those who do not follow the rules and instruction of the parking and security personnel. Any breach of these rules will be dealt with by security and reported to the Show Committee for appropriate action and with refund of fees.

Make All Checks and Money Orders PAYABLE TO JANIS MCMANIGAL, CANADIAN exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Tabulate carefully. Due to cost of processing no refunds of \$5.00 and under will be made. There is a \$4.00 fee for any entry cancellations.

A Recording Fee of .50 cents per dog and a Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry, \$3.00 Rally Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Rally Trial. These Fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Event Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Post Dated Checks, Returned Checks and Declined Credit Cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretaries will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. The returned check or declined credit card **MUST BE MADE GOOD** by cash or money order **BEFORE** the dog will be allowed in the ring.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. This club and its Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready for judging. In order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. It is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dogs presence is needed in the judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler to bring his dog into the ring.

The club, its secretaries or their employees will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show grounds.

Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Secretaries Office advised at once. The Secretaries and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

Trophies and Prizes will be awarded in the judging ring before the completion of judging, any discrepancies must be reported to the Secretary prior to completion of judging. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Conformation judging at the Show.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class after the closing of entries may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of the earliest Conformation judging or one half hour prior to the start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

Please DO NOT LEAVE ANY DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES. Do not leave your dogs in unlocked cars. If any dogs are seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures where it is confined without supervision, a California Humane Officer or a Security Officer will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the Show Committee for disciplinary action. all persons attending this show hereby waive any claim for damages against the show giving clubs or their members in the event a motor vehicle has to be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or improperly vented conditions. **THIS IS A SELF CLEANING SHOW, PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS.**

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veteran Dogs & Veteran Bitches - Veterans, 7 years & Older, Veteran Dogs & Bitches may be spayed or neutered at Specialty Shows (AKC Dog Show Rules, CH 11, Sec. 8)

Dual Champion Dogs or Bitches: The Dual Champion class is open to dogs and bitches that have achieved the AKC Conformation and Field Trial Championships.

Field Trial Dogs or Bitches - The Field Trial class is open to dogs and bitches that have placed in an American Kennel Club member or licensed Field Trial. Note: Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are eligible for entry in Dual Champion and Field Trial classes.

Hunt Test Dogs or Bitches - The Hunt Test class is open to dogs and bitches that have received a qualifying score or a title in an AKC Hunt Test.

Winners from these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed if otherwise undefeated on the day of the show.

BEST OF BREED (No defeated dogs will be allowed to compete) The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

AMATEUR OWNER HANDLER & BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY

Amateur Owner Handled Class Eligibility: SECTION 7. (effective as of 1/1/2009) The Amateur-Owner-Handler class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13). Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.

Bred-By-Exhibitor Class Eligibility: 1) Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show, 2) All dogs entered in the Bred By Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC as of the date of closing for the show. 3) The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog, 4) No Champions of Record on the date of closing entries for the show, 5) Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as the date of the closing of entries for the show. Ch. 3, Sec. 7 AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list.
